 - College Reading and Learning Association (CRLA) certified
 - Peer based
 - Tutors qualified by department faculty, tutor supervisor, and GPA
 - Tutors are set up, trained, and closely supervised by Suzanne Haas and Jodee Wilt
 - Tutor training – academic credit based class instructed by Jodee Wilt
 - Study Groups set up as needed
- College Study Strategies

 - One academic credit counting toward graduation
 - Offered first or second quarter
 - First and second year students eligible to enroll

2. Foundational Program (students with diagnosed disabilities)
